JOB SUMMARY

The Landscaper provides lawn and landscape maintenance for Parker School's 23 acre campus.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS (in order of priority with percentage of time spent on each)

60 %	<p>Lawn Maintenance</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Mow, trim, edge, and irrigate lawns with riding mower, edger or other machines and tools. Mix and spray or spread fertilizers, herbicides, or insecticides using hand or automatic sprayers or spreaders. Stripe athletic fields with manual striping machine.
30 %	<p>Landscape Maintenance</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Prune or trim trees, shrubs, plants, or hedges using shears, pruners, pole saws, or chainsaws. Plant, fertilize, irrigate, weed, mulch, and maintain decorative garden and flower beds. Gather and remove green waste and litter. Provide upkeep of sidewalks, driveways, parking lots, playgrounds, athletic courts, and other grounds features.
10 %	<p>Other Landscaping Duties</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Assist Maintenance Director with landscape related projects, such as but not limited to fence construction and repair, school projects/installations, etc. Provide basic maintenance of power equipment.

ADDITIONAL DUTIES

- Open school at the start of the school day, to include but not limited to unlocking gates to parking areas, locker rooms, restrooms, common areas, etc.
- Assist school administration with campus security as needed.

Exposure to dust, dirt, pollen, fertilizers, pesticides, herbicides, and gas fumes. Exposure to high noise levels. Standing, walking and repeated bending for extended periods throughout the day. Sitting for extended periods. Frequent, pushing, pulling, carrying, digging, sawing, blowing, raking, and heavy lifting required. Climbing ladders.
