in the afternoon. You will come to pick-up your child at the blue gate. All campers must be picked up by 4pm.

Backpacks

Each day your camper will come to camp with their own backpack that they will carry with the following either in their backpack or on their body (everything will go home each night with each camper):

- Dry change of clothes

- Sunscreen (Please apply sunscreen each morning before coming to camp)
- Tennis shoes with socks

- Lunch (can have something to be warmed up for 30 seconds max in a microwave by the camper)
- 2 snacks (one for morning and one for afternoon)

- Swimsuit
- Towel
- Hat
- Slippers
